

ELECTRIC POWER

All the villages in the Malappuram district are electrified. Almost 63.09 % of the total consumption is used for the domestic purposes. Only 12.11 % is used for the Industrial purposes. The nearest power generating station is at Kuttiady near Kozhikode. The extra high tension substation in the district is linked to the Kerala Power grid through EHT. The transmission networks consisting of two 220 KV feeder, nine 110 KV feeder, four 66 KV feeder, and thirteen 33 KV feeders. Moreover in the distribution section 2253 transformers are included. The length of HT lines is 1778 Km and the length of the LT lines is 9799 km. The total number of consumers in the district is 419564 in numbers. There are 28 substations with different capacity situated in the District. Moreover 2253 transformers, 1778km and 9799 km HT and LT lines are also there.
